COLOSSEUM

This is the main symbol of Italy.
It was an amphitheater in the ancient

TORRE DI PISA

One of the most important
monument in Italy. It is a bell tower

DUOMO DI MILANO (Cathedral)

Ruffo's CASTLE

This is a Norman castle, symbol of Nicotera. It was several times destroyed and rebuilt. It was property of *Ruffo Family* of Calabria.



ETNA volcano

Mount Etna is a volcano on the East coast of Sicily, part of southern Italy. It is the largest active volcano in Europe. Mount Etna erupts every few years.



Spaghetti

Spaghetti is a long, string-shaped kind of pasta. It comes from Italian *spaghetto*, which means "string". Spaghetti is made from wheat and it is boiled in water for a short time. Spaghetti can be served as a main dish with different kinds of sauce.



Nduja

This is a typical Calabrian spicy spreadable *salame*. It is made with parts of the pig, roasted peppers and a mixture of spices.



FERRARI

This is a luxury sport Italian cars brand. The company has been noted for its continued participation in racing, especially in *Formula One* where it is the oldest and most successful racing team.



TORTELLINI

Tortellini are ring-shaped pasta originally from the Italian region of Emilia. They are usually stuffed with a mix of meat, Parmigiano Reggiano cheese, egg and nutmeg. They are traditionally served in capon broth.
